Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction ("Motion").


In connection with the Motion, the Court has reviewed the following:

1 The Court has also reviewed the records and files herein. Being fully advised in this  
2 matter, the Court finds that Plaintiff has met the applicable burdens for a preliminary injunction,  
3 *(likelihood of preliminary on merits).*  
4 The Court finds that absent preliminary injunctive relief, there is a likelihood that the funds in  
5 dispute will be depleted, which will constitute irreparable injury to Plaintiff. Therefore, a  
6 preliminary injunction restraining the use or transfer of the funds in dispute is warranted.

7 Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that Plaintiff's  
8 Motion for Preliminary Injunction is GRANTED. Based on the above findings, it is ORDERED  
9 that Defendant is restrained from spending, transferring, encumbering or disposing property  
10 related in any way to the donation in dispute, including specifically with respect to any of the  
11 funds in the bank account(s) holding, in whole or in part, the proceeds from Plaintiff's  
12 December 2013 donation of the Facebook shares that are the subject of this lawsuit.
